1997- A year that changed fast-paced Dilip's life forever:

Dilip Patro, young and energetic software professional was on a visit to Mumbai when a road accident damaged his spine and left him paralyzed. He attained some physical movements through sheer grit and determination. Dilip spent 8 years glued to bed/wheelchair and at the mercy of care givers and constant non-affordability of expensive rehabilitation. In 2005, his life changed when he came to Mobility India.

2005- A year Dilip will remember for the rest of his life

Dilip came to Mobility India with the following needs.

- ♦ I want to move my lower limbs
- ♦ I want to write
- ♦ I want to use the toilet without medical intervention and care givers
- ♦ I want to achieve better overall coordination for all my limbs..."

He wondered "am I asking too much?" (Remembering his past experiences with various hospitals.)

It was a combined effort of the therapists, orthotists that worked on getting Dilip up on his feet as well as design many devices and adaptations to make his daily activities like shaving, brushing to writing and using the laptop easier. The R&D team also adapted his wheelchair for him.
